will soon discover from these recollections that one certainly did in Peru in the form of Anita Goulden.

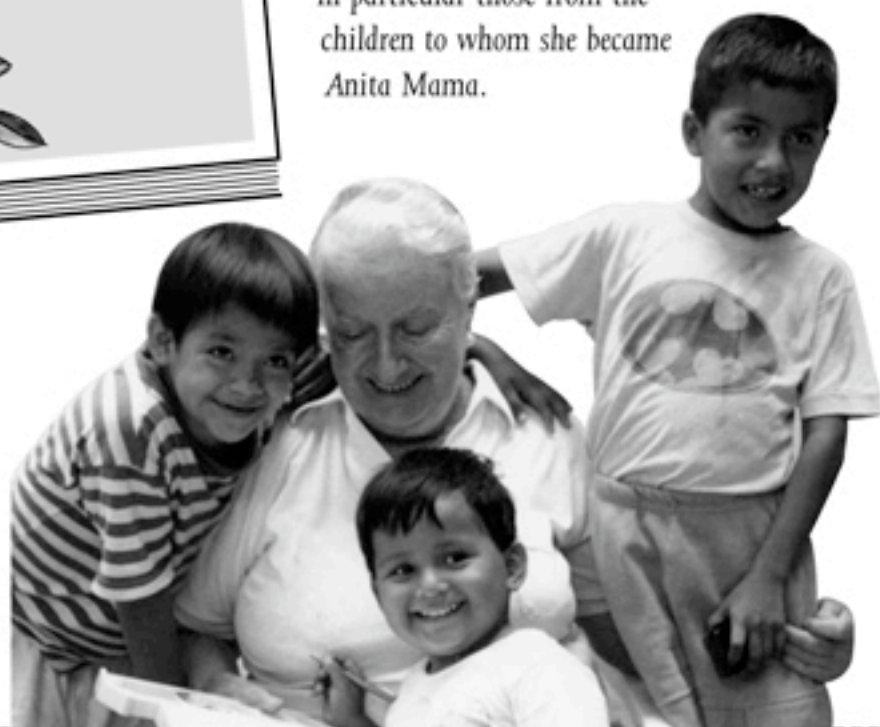
